## 2011 "Little Pilot" Summer Camp

### Workshop General Information

- **Workshop Introduction**
- There are a total of 6 workshops, each of which is developed closely from its individual concept but at the same time group together to build a consequential structure. All in all, the workshops can be divided into two principal themes:

The first three workshops belongs to "I want to be a pilot" series and talk about aerospace and airplanes, they contain atmospheric structure, weather behavior and its effects on the airplane, the history of aircrafts, airplane structure, principles of flight, airport support facilities and pilot career. The whole theme focuses on the flying experience to give the kids an exciting adventure into aviation field.

The second three workshops called "I am a pilot" series take a number of representative airports in the world to demonstrate vividly how flying can be fun and exciting. For example, Paro Airport, the only international airport of Bhutan which surrounded peaks as high as 18,000 ft (5,500 m) it is considered one of the world's most challenging airports, only eight pilots in the world are certified to land at this airport and flights to Paro are allowed only under visual meteorological conditions and restricted to daylight hours from sunrise to sunset.

- **Encourage parents' participation and coordination with kids during and after lessons;**

Unlike most of the other extracurricular activities in which the parents are totally not involved, our summer camp encourage that whenever possible, the parents can come with the kids. Our integration of games and projects and our workshop structure designed to be relatively independent for each lesson makes it easy for the parents to participate;

- **Reputation among different kindergarten, schools and other educational institutions;**

We work with many primary and secondary schools all over Hong Kong and our pilots often conduct presentations in schools and public events. These experiences give us a good reputation among schools as a credible and competent actor in children education;

- **Experience flying in real simulators you find nowhere else in Asia;**

The equipment we have offer the kids the opportunity to "fly" a flight simulator that is about as close as it gets to the real Boeing 737-800NG plane. 585 buttons, 300 lights and indicators, 6 computer screens, the scenery outside. Every kid would be super excited about it;

- **Small classes of 8 to give your children special attention**

We value the importance of giving each kid individual attention and their parents timely feedback, thus we deliberately structure our lessons into two 40 minutes sections switching between the simulator and the lecture. Each instructor only takes care of 4 kids. So we can best satisfy each kid's specific need.

The composition of the group, nevertheless, will change from time to time. So they will become friends with all other kid in the same workshop. We are aware of the importance to work with people from different backgrounds, with different abilities and different personalities, and we think it needs to start from young.

5 to 12 is the period when the kids and parents should maintain close interaction and then the parent need the most advice and information from other channels. Our cooperation with other education institutions to like YCMA, JJ Treehouse and Hong Kong Science Museum enable us to obtain a thorough understanding of children education. Our instructors will fill in a performance evaluation chart for all kids after each workshop from which you can get some insight into the merits and improvement points of your own kid.

- **Totally flexible time schedule;**

Six theme workshops are mutually independent but at the same time interconnected. We offer two lessons from 9:00 am -10:30 am and 10:30 am -12:00 pm on different themes.
